

Author Instructions and Style Criteria and Guidelines

Submission

Please submit the text of the paper you intend to publish in this journal to the address redazione@speculaiuris.it.

Biography and E-mail address

The author of the paper shall include a short personal biography (concerning her/his current academic position and including the main information describing her/his scientific profile) and provide her/his e-mail address.

Abstract

The author of the article must provide a short abstract of her/his contribution (10-15 lines) in Italian and in English.

Key words

Please add a list of 3-5 keywords both in Italian and English.

Review

Any feature allowing the identification of the author of the contribution from the file will be removed before the peer review process.

Format and Style Guidelines

Please submit your essay as a *.doc or *.rtf document.

Capital letters can be used only when referring to centuries or historical events (e.g.: XVIIth century, XXth Congress of the CCP).

Long quotations must be separated from the preceding and following part of the text by inserting a blank line before and after quotations.

In case of short quotations in the text and quotations in the footnotes, please use the following quotation marks: «...». Write the text inside the quotation marks in Roman characters.

Quotations in Latin must be written in Italics, without quotation marks. Quotations in Greek must be written in Roman characters, without quotation marks.

When interrupting the quotation, please write as follows: modern languages: [...]

Abbreviations: a c. di (in round brackets, postponed to the name of the editors); éd./éds. (éditeur/s); ed./eds. (editor/s); Hrsg. (Herausgeber); c./cc. (colonna/e); cfr. (confronta); l./ll. (linea/e); vd. (vedi/see); p./pp. (pagina/e); nt./ntt. (footnote/s); n./nn. (number/s); trad. (translated by); rist. (reprinted); s./ss. (following); p. es. (for example); fig./figg. (figure/s); e.g. (*exempli gratia*); i.e. (*id est*); s.v. (*sub voce*).

Style citations in the footnotes: please write the surname of the author in small capital characters, followed by the year of publication of the work and the numbers of pages:

GUARINO 1963, p. 277 nt. 30.

BEDUSCHI 1999, p. 28.

TORRENT 2008, p. 271 ss.

In the footnotes, in case of several works by the same author published in the same year, please add a lowercase after the year as follows:

LONGO 1933a, p. 183 ss.

LONGO 1933b, p. 653.

When referring to an edition of the work following the first edition, please use a superscript after the year of publication as follows:

WATSON 1966², p. 62 ss.

Please pay attention that all the bibliographical references must be written out in full at the end of the contribution according to the following guidelines:
